

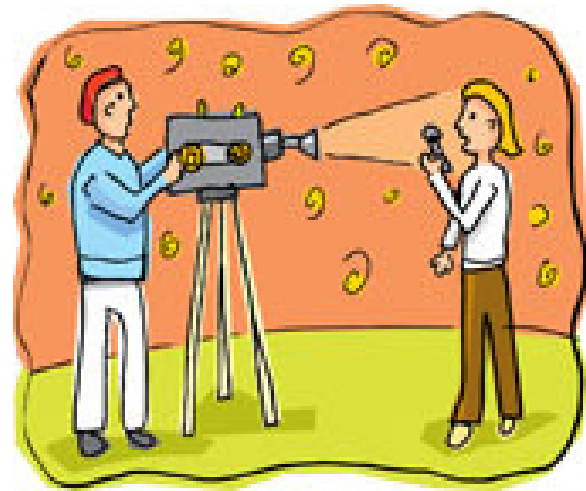


Media Training
