

## **Making Videos on Portable Devices: Workshops with David Pyefinch**



**The aim of the workshop is to demystify making your own short form stories for the web. This is a hands-on workshop. There will be opportunities to discuss any issues and questions you may have and a look at how you can make your own videos for the web using quick and simple methods.**

David has been working in media for over 30 years. David conducted 3 regional media training workshops for Houses as part of the Emerging Voices project in early 2018. He returned in late 2018 to run a workshop at the NHT Conference on the basics of making short videos about the activities and stories you want to tell from your House.

David is back in May 2019 to run these 3 regional media workshops on capturing the story using phones or tablets and then editing it for use. Each workshop will be hands-on, with filming in the morning and editing in the afternoon session.

Numbers for each workshop are limited so that participants will get direct support and assistance from David throughout the workshop. Once signed up for a workshop there will be some homework to ensure that your device (smart phone or tablet) is ready to go with the right app on the day.

These workshops are heavily subsidised by NHT through a Skills Tasmania grant. They provide a great opportunity to get some hands-on training by an expert in the media field on how to tell and present a story from your House.
